Handing over of Charge: The meeting started with the transfer of Coordinator charge by Dr. Lalrinpuia Vangchhia to Dr. K. Lalzuimawia for the 4th Cycle (2022-2027) of NAAC Accreditation.

On the request of the chairman, the Coordinator summarized the agendas of the meeting, which were thus opened for consideration.

Report on the formation of IQAC:

1. During 21st and 22nd January 2022, National Assessment and Accreditation Council Peer Team visited Govt. Hnahthial College for the 3rd Cycle of NAAC Accreditation. The result of NAAC Institutional Assessment and Accreditation was declared on 25.1.2022 in which the college was Accredited with the Criterion-wise Grade Point Averages of 2.5 on four point scale at 'B' Grade valid up to January 24, 2027.

2. As per the guidelines for the Creation of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and Submission of Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) by Accredited Institutions (For affiliated / Constituent Colleges) (Revised on 20th February 2020) of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, and the guidelines of University Grants Commission (12th Plan guidelines for Establishment and Monitoring of the IQACs in Colleges), the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Govt. Action Taken Report:

- On 2nd July, 2021 the NSS renovated its assets at the campus by repairing and re-painting the park benches at 'NSS Park'.
- During 26th 27th July 2021, "Orientation for Students" was organized by Internal Quality

Assurance Cell (IQAC), Govt. Hnahthial College.

- 3. On 26th July 2021, "Bridge Course" was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in collaboration with NSS Unit Govt. Hnahthial College. The purpose of the programme is to bridge the gap between the curricular and extra-curricular frameworks as well as its implementation strategies at higher secondary school and college levels.
- On 28th July 2021, Staff Welfare Election was held at College Seminar Hall.
- 5. On 28th July 2021, Staff Welfare Committee organized farewell programme for college peon Mr. Lalzarliana on the superannuation retirement from his service. The programme was attended by 20 Teaching staffs and 6 Non-Teaching staffs.
- On 7th August 2021, the faculty members of the College carried out social work Programme at the College Campus.
- 7. On 12th August 2021, Innovation and Best Practices Cell Awarded 'Johann Memorial Award for Academic Exellence' to R. Lalkhawngaiha from Mizo Department for securing highest mark from the College. Certificate and cash incentive was awarded by the Principal.
- 8. On 15th August 2021, the Teaching Staffs attended Independence Day Celebration Programme at D.C's Office Complex Hnahthial.
- 9. On 20th August 2021, The Department of History organized Invited Lecture on "Land Tenure System During Colonial Period in Mizoram". Dr. O. Rosanga, (Professor Rtd.), Department of History and Ethnography, Mizoram University delivered a lecture on the introduction of land revenue system by the British colonial administration the changes and its impact in Mizoram.
 - 10. On 20th August 2021, The Department of History organized Special Lecture on "Jewish movement in North East India". Dr. Lalrinnunga Hmar, Assistant Professor. Department of History, Govt. Degree College, Tripura delivered a lecture on the movement of various ethnic groups in north-east India who identify themselves as descendants of the Jews and analyzes the religious, social and economic impact of the movement on these sects in North East India.

- 23. On 21st October 2021, IQAC, Govt. Hnahthial College Organized Faculty Development Programme on "Teaching Strategies during Covid 19 Pandemic". Interaction and training programme had also been done for the maximum utilization of online means of teaching and evaluation. The programme was attended by twenty four teachers.
- 24. On 22nd October 2021, Information and Communication Technology Department handed over 10 sets of computer for the implementation of the NIELIT Study Centre, which is to be opened to provide Add on /Certificate "Course on Computer Concept" for the students and other stakeholders. - 26. As part of the "New India 75" campaign in celebration of Azadi ka Anti Makorsa Red Ribbon Club of the college organized 'Painting / Sketching / Poster Making Competition' for the students. The result was declared on 2nd November 2021 and was won by Lalliannghaka of V Semester.
- 27. On 2nd November, 2021, the Students' Union organised Graduation Day at College Auditorium which was attended by Mr. Lalremsanga MCS, Deputy Commissioner, Hnahthial District as Chief Guest.
- 28. On 17.11.2021, NSS implemented environment conservation programme by clearing weeds

and fencing the saplings planted at College Campus. Three Programme Officers and forty five (M-23, F-22) volunteers participated in this post-plantation programme

- 29. On 24th November, 2021, Eco Club, Govt. Hnahthial College installed 'Eco-Garden Hoarding' at the Eco Garden. The hoarding is expected to create awareness on its environmental targets.
- 30. On 25th November 2021, Govt. Hnahthial College has gone through its **First Cycle of External/Internal Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)** in which the college scored 62.6% with aggregate Institutional points of 939.
- 31. On 21st & 28th November 2021, Innovation and Best practices Cell organized "Children's Book Distribution Programme" at Electric Veng and Model Veng.
- 32. On 1st December, 2021, World AIDS Day was observed by Red Ribbon Club by displaying and installing banner at campus which bears the message 'End Inequalities, End AIDS, End Pandemics'. The programme was observed by eight persons from the faculty members and students of the college.
- 33. During 6th -11th December 2021, NSS organized "Winter Special Camping" at South Phaileng. During this camp, a new double compartment Public toilet was constructed with RCC type. Volunteers also carried out distribution of sweets and NSS pamphlets, cleanliness drive covering the whole village.
