

## **Feedback on Govt. Hnahthial College from Students, Parents, Alumni and Teachers 2022-23**

Feedback on curriculum has been obtained from students, parents and alumni through well framed questionnaires on the following parameters - Curricular, Infrastructure, Fee Structure, Teacher Students relation, Non-Teaching/Staff - Students relations, Extra Curricular Activity, Financial Aid (Free Feeship etc).

With regard to feedback collected from the students, 9.6% opined curricular is excellent, 36.5% (very good), 50% (good) and 3.8 % opined as fair. In terms of infrastructure, 17.3% opined that it is excellent while 36.5 % said it is very good. Most of the students opined that Infrastructure is good (50 %) while 3.8 % rated it as fair. 7.7% of the students said that the current fee structure is excellent, 26.9% opined it as very good and majority of the students rated it as good (61.5%) whereas 1.9 % rated it is as fair and bad respectively. The Feedback also indicates that Teacher- Students' relation as well as Non-Teaching/Staff – Students' relations is very good as most students chose excellent, very good and good in the parameter. In response to Extra Curricular Activity, 9.6% consider it as excellent, 19.2% as very good, while majority of the students (59.6%) opined it as good. At the same time, there were few responses (7.7%) who rated it as fair and 3.8% as bad. The range of opinions further differed with regard to Financial Aid (Free Feeship etc). 7.7 % rated it as excellent while 25 % opined that it is very good. Most of the respondents rated it as good (57.7%) with 7.7 % who consider it as fair and 1.9 % as bad.

Parent's feedbacks have been collected similarly. 15% of the parents opined that the curriculum for students is excellent. Most of the parents (more than 70%) opined the curriculum is good enough. With regard to institutional infrastructure 5.6 % has rated it as excellent, Very good (50%), Good (22.8%), and Fair (16.7%) respectively. Fee structure of the Institution is considered to be very good (61.1%) and good (27.8%). In terms of extra-curricular activities, majority of the parents rated it as good (72.2%) while 16.7% regard it as very good. 5.6 % of the respondents rated it as fair and poor respectively. The ratings in respect of financial aid is good (72.2%) while 11.1% rated it as very good, opinions on fair and bad are 11.1% and 5.6 %.

Feedback from the College Alumni has also been collected. With regard to curriculum, 15.8 % opined it as excellent while 31.6 % said it is very good and 47.4% rated it as good. For Infrastructure, 31.6% of the alumni respondents opined the institution as excellent whereas the remaining 42.1 % choose very good and 21.1 % rated it as good. The opinion on the fee structure ranges from 10.5% as excellent, 26.3% as very good and 31.6 % rating it as good and fair respectively. In terms of Teacher –Student relationship the alumni rated the college as excellent (36.8%), very good (31,6%) and good (31,6%). With regard to Extra –curricular and financial aid, most of the respondents rated it as good enough while some (21.1%) rated it as fair.

Feedback has been also taken from the teachers on five parameters – whether Curriculum is relevant for - employability, innovative thinking, skill oriented human resources, is need based and for development of entrepreneurship. Generally all the teachers of the institution agree the current curriculum is good enough in respect to all the parameters. Most of the teachers (57.9%) agree that curriculum is relevant for employability and that Curriculum is effective in developing innovative thinking (73.7%). Further 73% of the teachers agree that Syllabus effective in developing skill oriented human resources while another 10.5% are neutral. 78.9 % of the teachers agree that the syllabus is need based while 10.5 % are neutral in this respect. On the effectiveness of the curriculum for development of entrepreneurship, 47% agree to it while 26.3 % disagreed and at the same time 26.3% are neutral in this regard.
